College Scholarship Application 2011

Applicants must be entering college, or full-time college or graduate school students (including Medical, Law, or any other school of higher learning) who are members of Saint Barbara Greek Orthodox Church in Orange, Connecticut and in certain cases, from other Greek Orthodox Churches in the Greater New Haven area.. (Church membership is interpreted to include the applicant's participation in the Sacramental life of the Church and family participation in the Church's Stewardship Program).

The completed application form must be returned in a sealed envelope to the Saint Barbara Church c/o Scholarship Committee by June 15, 2011 and must include a recent academic transcript and at least one current (within the last six months) letter of reference from a faculty member on official letterhead from the applicant's school. The letter may be sent directly to the Church or could be signed, sealed, and signed again on the flap of the envelope by the reviewer and given to the student to include in the application packet.

Applicants for an AHEPA Scholarship must submit two such letters of reference, and in addition list employment history, academic honors, accomplishments and scholarships received in the past.

Students applying for a scholarship that is based on financial need must also submit the last page (confirmation page) of the FAFSA application.

It is the responsibility of the applicant to ensure that all requested information is received by the Church Office no later than June 15, 2011. The Scholarship Committee will not consider any incomplete or late application. Please note that all information included in this application will remain confidential.
